Federal Election Law requires us to report the name, address, occupation, and employer for contributions aggregating in excess of \$200 in an election cycle. The maximum an individual may contribute is \$2,600 for the primary cycle and an additional \$2,600 for the general cycle. Couples may contribute \$5,200 for the primary cycle and an additional \$5,200 for the general cycle, respectively. Federal PACs may contribute \$5,000 for each election. Contributions from corporations, labor unions, federal government contractors, national banks, and foreign nationals without permanent residency status are prohibited.
